

SEAMS:

Carpet usually comes in 12-foot widths, making seams necessary in most rooms. Visible seams are not a defect unless they have been improperly made or the material has a defect, making the seam more pronounced than normal. It is highly recommended to apply seam sealer to all seams at time of installation. The more dense and uniform the carpet texture, the more visible the seams will be. Seams shouldn't be more visible than when the carpet is first installed. With frequent vacuuming, the seams should become less visible.
